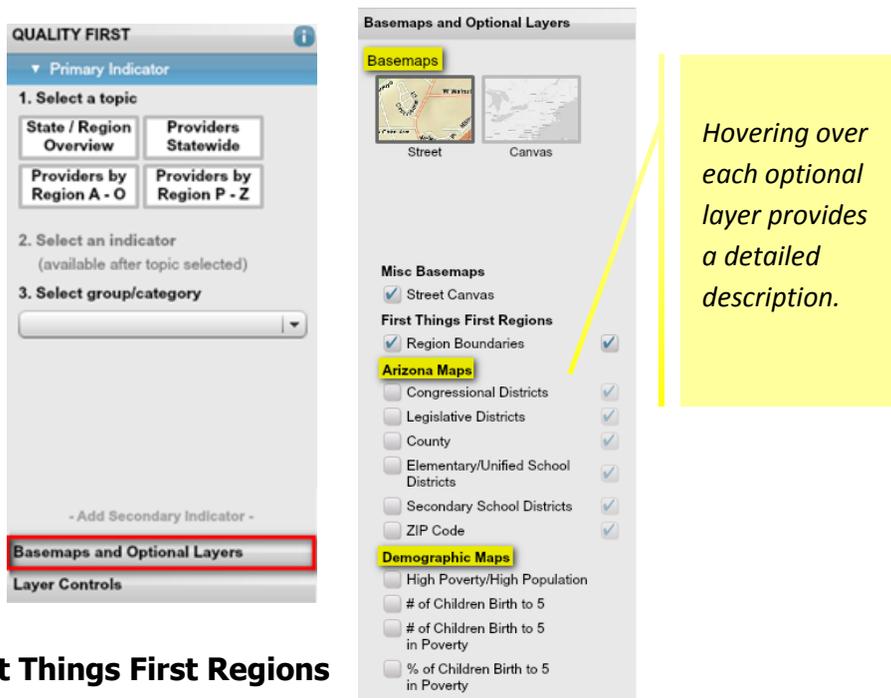


Basemaps and Optional Layers

How to add an additional basemap/optional layer to your view:

To insert an additional basemap to your view, click the **Basemaps and Optional Layers** tab located towards the bottom of the contents pane. This opens a new panel with options for changing the basemap or adding defining boundaries and optional thematic demographic maps.



First Things First Regions

- Regional Boundaries** delineates the 28 Regional Partnership Council areas as **black** boundary lines.

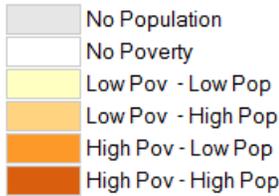
Arizona Maps

- Secondary School Districts (15) (azgeo.az.gov 2015) - **purple** lines
- ZIP Code (2012) - **red** lines

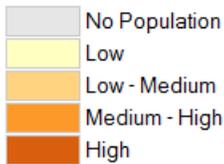

- High Poverty/High Population

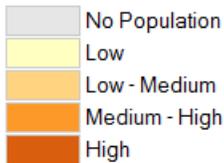
Children Birth to 5 from 2010 U.S. Census Bureau, 2007-2011 American Community Survey; (Pop. at 100% FPL)
